

2025 CPHA FOUNDATION EQUITATION QUALIFYING CLASS

- Open to Junior and Amateur riders who are current members of the CPHA, to be judged over an equitation type course of at least 8 fences 3'3" in height with at least 2 USEF tests (2,8,10,12,16,17,18,20) included as part of the course.
- Trainers of riders in this class must be professional members of the CPHA.
- This class will be judged by the current standards of the USEF Hunter Seat Equitation.
- This class may be held in hunter or jumper rings; if held in the jumper ring a liverpool may be used.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 21/under riders must earn 6 points during the qualifying season, which begins
 immediately following the previous year's final and continues until the current year's
 final, to qualify for the Championships.
- 14/under and 22/over riders must ride in one class during the qualifying period to qualify for the Championships.
- All riders may continue to ride in the class for their age break division's year-end high point award, and to support the CPHA Foundation with your entry fees.
- The high point division leaders will receive special awards from the California Professional Horsemen's Association Foundation at its annual awards presentation held at the CPHA Awards Banquet.
- Points are awarded: 10-6- 4- 3- 2.
- Three (3) riders must complete the course for the class to count as a qualifier.
- Tack allowed per USEF EQ106.5. a.1.2.3.

The qualifying period will be from the first weekend after the finals to the last weekend before the next finals.

*** Any class with 30 or more riders the class must be split (California split) with two sets of awards and two sets of ribbons to be distributed.

**** Trainers and riders must be members of the CPHA prior to riding in this class
